Phil Clark AM is a member of the J P Morgan Advisory Council and was recently appointed Chair of the Federal Government's Higher Education Endowment Fund (HEEF) Advisory Board.

He was Managing Partner and CEO of Minter Ellison and worked with that firm from 1995 until June 2005.

Prior to joining Minter Ellison, Phil was Director and Head of Corporate with ABN Amro Australia and prior to that he was Managing Partner of Mallesons Stephen Jaques for 15 years. Earlier in his career he worked with a Pratt Industries subsidiary and with Shell Australia.

Until his retirement from the Business Council of Australia in June 2005 he was a member of the BCA and served on the BCA Education Task Force. He was the BCA representative on the RQF Expert Advisory Group and the RQF Development Advisory Group.

His current directorships include ING Management Limited (the Responsible Entity for five listed and two unlisted ING Real Estate Trusts) CRI Asset Management Limited, The Garvan Foundation, St James Ethics Centre and he is Executive Chairman of DJ Clark Limited.
