Reg Howard-Smith was appointed Chief Executive of the Chamber of Minerals and Energy, Western Australia (CME) in November 2008.

The CME is the peak advocacy group for the resources sector in Western Australia representing companies that contribute over 90% of the State's mining and oil and gas production and exploration expenditure.

From 2002 to 2007 Reg was a Director with the CME with responsibilities in the areas of Human Resources, Occupational Health and Safety, Education and Training, Immigration, Skill shortage initiatives and Finance.
