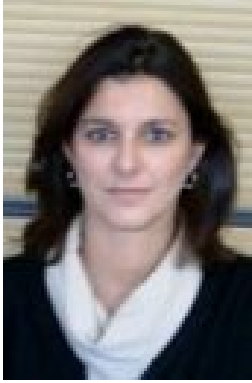


Dr Rosa Scoble
