

NEW CHAIR FOR ATN

Professor Denise Bradley is to take up the position of Chair of the Australian Technology Network of Universities.

Professor Bradley, who is the Vice Chancellor of the University of South Australia, replaces Queensland University of Technology Vice Chancellor, Professor Peter Coaldrake who was Chair from May 2003.

Professor Bradley was appointed Vice Chancellor in 1997. She has been extensively involved in national educational policy groups and was a member of Minister Brendan Nelson's Higher Education Review Reference Group. She is a current AVCC Board member and is Chair of the IDP.

As well as contributing to the ongoing policy debate on the key issues of access, equity and diversity, the ATN will play a major role in the development of the Research Quality Framework for publicly funded research through its representation on the Government's Expert Advisory Group.

The ATN teaches more than 175,000 students and employs some 13,000 staff.
