ATN/University of Waterloo Researcher Exchange Program

**Commencing 2010 – to promote research collaboration
between the University of Waterloo (Ontario) and the
member universities of the ATN**



Funds will be made available via an application/ranking process for researcher exchanges (between Canada and Australia) of up to 2 months per exchange

Total funding available, and hence number of projects funded in 2010, will be decided by ATN universities and the University of Waterloo after ranking of applications



- **Researchers from all areas may apply**
- **Target areas for 2010 are renewable energy, environment, climate change, water, health, sustainable engineering and nanotechnology_**
- **The Program looks especially to encourage projects that involve multiple (up to 3 preferred) ATN universities**



- **Applications to be submitted by March 31st, 2010**
- **Applications to be submitted concurrently through the lead ATN university and by Canadian partner researcher into the University of Waterloo.**
- **Funding for approved Projects available from July 1st through December 31st, 2010**
